
# Library Partners & Their Roles (You and your library are not alone)





#### The Public Library Services Branch (PLSB)

- Public Library Services is a branch of Alberta Municipal Affairs. The
   PLSB is responsible for provincial legislation and policies that provide a
   legal framework and network for public libraries:
  - The Libraries Act and The Libraries Regulation
  - Provincial Resource Sharing and Network Policies
- Your library board is required by legislation to submit to the PLSB:
  - Its Bylaws and Policies (and updates)
  - An Annual Report (online through LibPAS)
  - A Plan of Service (every 3-5 years)
- Your library board applies annually to the PLSB for an operating grant.

### Your Municipal Council


- Establishes your library board. \*
- Approves and appoints library board members.
- Provides operating funds to run the library.
- Pays for membership in Peace Library System, so that your library can receive enhanced services and municipal residents can borrow from the Provincial Library Network.
- \* Special circumstances apply to eight libraries including Bear Point, DeBolt, Dixonville, Keg River, Menno-Simons, Paddle Prairie, St. Isidore, and Worsley. Contact your consultant for details.

#### Your Library Board

- Hires and employs the Library Manager.
- Creates bylaws and policies to govern the library.
- Approves the library's annual budget and requests an operating grant from municipal council.
- Provides funds for library purchases through PLS (allotments).
- Approves the library's annual report submitted to the PLSB.
- Applies annually to the PLSB for an operating grant.
- Completes a community needs assessment and develops the library's Plan of Service (submitted to the PLSB every 3-5 years).





#### Peace Library System

- Connects you and 44 other public libraries in northwest Alberta to the Provincial Library Network.
- Holds your board's allotment funds so you can conveniently purchase books and materials through us for your collection.
- Provides assistance with purchasing.
- Catalogues and "shelf-readies" your purchases.
- Provides consulting and training for library managers and staff.
- Delivers to most libraries within 200 km of Grande Prairie.
- Provides access to eResources.
- Provides website & eMail hosting & other technology resources.
- Together with 3 other Library Systems forms TRAC (The Regional Automation Consortium).




